

How to Read Your Water Meter

We utilize two types of Meters – These Meters are read automatically when we drive by them so we do not have to get out and read the meter. A Computer program reads them for us.

This meter does not have a sweep hand like the one on the right. You read the meter from left to right. The last number is a decimal. This meter is reading 25.1 gallons.



This meter has a sweep hand like a clock. Each number is 1 gallon. The last number does not move. Read the meter from left to right. This meter is reading 471260.



Snowflake

We are now installing new cellular read meters in certain areas. If the meter lid has a black piece sticking up you have a cellular meter. These meters are read daily by cell phone. You can download an app on your phone, EYEONWATER, and you can read it daily too. It can also notify you of a leak. Contact us for help.



Both of these meters has a “snowflake”. When the “snowflake” is turning there is water passing through the meter. If you think you have a leak turn off all your water and check to see if the “snowflake” is still turning.
